# Our schools and colleges



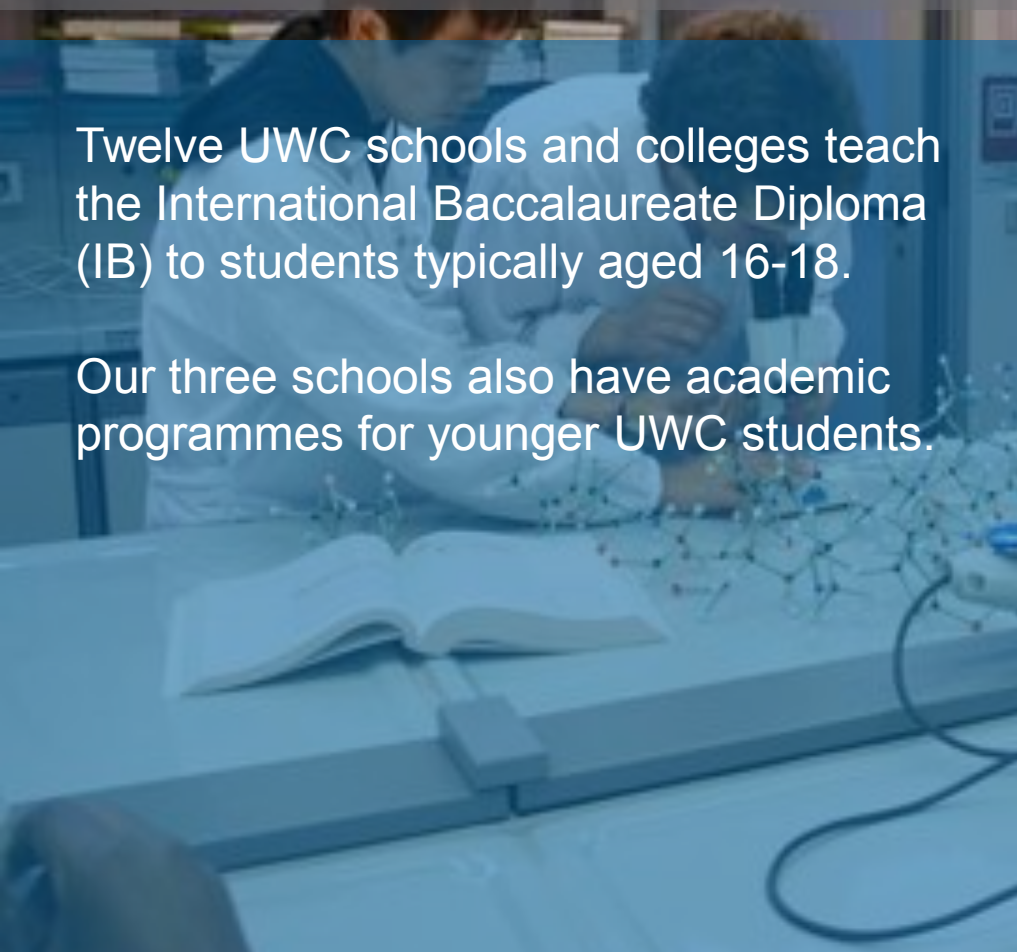
Note: Students at all the pre-university UWC colleges are aged 16-18.
